The strip is grass 2400' long and 90' wide on the south side of the 401 just 2 km from the Quebec border. Drive in access from Old hwy 2. Take the Riviere Beaudette exit south and go west on old hwy 2 for 4 km or take exit 825 south and go east 2km on old hwy 2. Note that all circuits are to the North. The date is Labour Day the 6th of Sept. a Monday this year as every year. Hotdogs, hamburgers and corn from 1130 to 1400.
